



You need to register to vote if you have moved, changed your name, just became eligible to vote, or have not voted in the last four years. Voter registration applications are available online (links below) or at the Township or County Offices.

To be eligible to vote, a person must be 18 years of age or older the day of the election, a US Citizen, and maintained residence in MN for 20 days preceding the election.

Who can vote in Minnesota

You must be:

- A U.S. citizen
- At least 18 years old on Election Day
- A resident of Minnesota for 20 days
- Finished with [all parts of any felony sentence](#)

You can vote while [under guardianship](#) unless a judge specifically has revoked your right to vote.

You cannot vote if a court has ruled that you are legally incompetent.
