Meeting called to order at 7:00pm and recited the Pledge of Allegiance

GUESTS:

APPROVE MINUTES: Review Regular meeting minutes 4/5/2022: **Dave makes a motion to approve the regular monthly minutes from 4/5/2022 as written, Nick 2nd, vote 3-0 passes.**

Clerk/Treasurers Report:

- Presented Treasurers report for April to the Board for filing. No discrepancies to report.
- Accounts Payable: **Brant makes a motion to approve all payables, Nick 2nd, vote 3-0 passes**
- ARPA reporting: Deadline of April 30th has been met.

Maintenance Business: **Dave made a motion to approve \$1500.00 for cold patch, Brant 2nd, vote 3-0 passes** Discussed more clean-up along railroad. On hold until confirm with CP.

Old Business:

- Bathrooms at Park: Submitted the grant and necessary documents. Won't find out until sometime in June if approved.
- Termite damage: Reviewed the report from the engineer. Some floor joist and re-strengthening of the office area are needed. Will review further and revisit costs at the June meeting.
- Clean-up/Rummage Sale: Clean-up day went well. Still need a bit more rubber matting at the park. Rummage Sale traffic was slow. Will plan to hold again this Friday and Sat and then items will be donated to the Exchange or Good Steward.
- Tree in ROW: Dave will get a hold of Baumgartner again and ask about the tree on Town Hall property along the fence as well.
- Fence at Town Hall: Discussion again about what to do with the fence on Town Hall property? It was discovered at clean-up day that the front portion of the fence is barely holding and there is a tree that may need to be removed or at least part of the tree. The back section of the fence was supposed to come down, but the residents South of Town Hall put it back up. **Brant makes a motion to remove the entire fence, returning the posts of the back section to the residents to the South and donating the good fence sections to the Friends of Dresbach, Dave 2nd, Nick opposes, vote 2-1 passes.**
- Culvert Old Mill Rd: Discussion about whether to replace the culvert with metal or concrete culvert. The difference in price is about \$3000.00. **Brant made a motion to approve the concrete culvert for Old Mill Rd, Nick 2nd, 3-0 passes.** Will need to schedule/coordinate the work with Zenke and CP
- Siding at Town Hall: Kim spoke with the contractor and confirmed a start date of June 15th.

New Business:

- Donation to the cemetery: Funds were approved at the Annual meeting. Payment will be issued for the June meeting.
- Dumpster Day: Saturday, May 14th from 7:30-4:00
- Special May Election: Election will be held on Tuesday, May 24, 2022. Polling place will be at the Dakota Community center like normal. Polls are open 7:00am-8:00pm.
- Concrete parking stops: Bruce Nordeen offered to the Township (2) concrete stops that were found on his property. If the Township can use them, they are welcome to them. **Brant makes a motion to accept the donation, Dave 2nd, vote 3-0 passes.** Supervisors will work with Maintenance to get them and place at the park or at Town Hall.
- Concrete at the Boat Landing: Bid was received for over \$38,000.00 from Brennan. We will try and get another bid. May not have the funds to do this project this year. May need to add to the 10 year capital plan and budget for it. Kim suggested filling out another grant application for this project. **Nick makes a motion to apply for grant funds from the County, Brant 2nd, vote 3-0 passes**
- Gravel needed: Lanes Valley and Buehler roads need some gravel added. Estimated need of 2 loads for each road. **Dave makes a motion to purchase 4 loads of gravel for Lanes Valley Rd and Buehler Road, Nick 2nd, vote 3-0 passes**
- Road Bid: 2022 Roads. Received bid from Scott's (\$41,260.00). Bid came under what was budgeted for (\$49,498.00). **Dave made a motion to approved the \$41,260.00 bid from Scott's, Nick 2nd, vote 3-0 passes.** May need to add some sweeping too. Road list: Dickson Road, Waas Valley Dr, Old Hickory Ln, Oak Hill Dr, Burns Valley Rd (top section), Cemetery Parking lot, Boat Ramp parking area and small section of Old Hickory Rd
- Bruch Hog: Will table until June. Need to get a hold of CP

From the Floor:

- Grass cutting: Will need to get gravel cleaned up. Mowing contractor will be here next week.
- New attorney needed: Will review the new person recommended by current attorney. Need contact information and pricing.
- Waas Valley Culvert: recommending Travis Zenke look at repairing or replacing culvert. Kim asked again about a list of culverts in Dresabch Township for the records. Nothing has been found since she started here in 2017.

Dave made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:08pm
