Meeting called to order at 7:00pm and recited the Pledge of Allegiance

GUESTS: Marcia Ward-Updates from Legislature, new jail in Winona, round abouts in Winona, upcoming elections and property values.

APPROVE MINUTES: Review Regular meeting minutes 5/3/2022: **Brant makes a motion to approve the regular monthly minutes from 5/3/2022 as written, Nick 2nd, vote 3-0 passes.**

Clerk/Treasurers Report:

- Presented Treasurers report for May to the Board for filing. No discrepancies to report.
- Accounts Payable: **Nick makes a motion to approve all payables, Brant 2nd, vote 3-0 passes**
- ARPA reporting: Deadline of April 30th has been met.

Maintenance Business: Siding on Town Hall is planned for June 15th to start. Ryan gave the Board a quote for 2 new front tires for the Town truck. Estimate of \$794.95. **Nick made a motion to approve the purchase of new tires, Brant 2nd, vote 3-0 passes** Discussion about Queens Cove and Oak Hill Culverts. Clean out culverts and possible replace.

Old Business:

- Bathrooms at Park: No updates. Marcia mentioned that Winona hasn't started reviewing applications
- Termite damage: No new updates. Discussed at last meeting
- Tree in ROW: Still have tree debris that needs to be cleaned up. Also, the portion of the tree on the Southside of Town Hall has been removed. Discussed with resident the flowers along the property line where the fence was. Perhaps FOD can find a new home or manage?
- Culvert Old Mill Rd: Dave will follow up with Travis to see if can coordinate a start date yet this year. Need to contact the Railroad to arrange.
- Dumpster Day update: This year was under budget. Spent about \$1700.00 and budgeted \$2000.00. New location has been working great for the past couple years.
- Road Chip Seal schedule: Planning for road repairs starting at the end of June/beginning of July. Need to get "loose gravel" signs in place, letters to residents on those roads and a letter to the property owner on Waas Valley regarding transition by the garage. Added a few more areas to the Road maintenance bid. Heavy single chip seal to 3 County Road 1 intersections (Buehler Ridge, Lanes Valley and Oak Hill Drive) Estimate for \$5352.00. **Brant made a motion to approve the \$5352.00 added repairs, Nick 2nd, vote 3-0 passes**

New Business:

- Friends of Dresbach Rummage Sale: The rummage sale this year didn't have much traffic. Tried 3 different days and raised about \$600.00. Thank you to everyone that donated this year.
- Crystal update: So far, the Town has received payments in the total of \$2600.00. Will follow up next month with Winona if additional payments have not been received.
- Mulder Road run off: Discussed the amount of debris, mud and water that continues to be an issue on Mulder Road. Kim has a few videos from last Fall and she will follow up with the Railroad to see if something can be done to improve the water flow.

From the Floor:

- Bricks/Concrete at Nordeens: Discussion about the Township being able to use the bricks/concrete that Nordeen's have. Ryan mentioned he may be able to use on a section of Oak Hill to stabilize. Need to talk to the Benson's about putting the bricks/concrete there. Will update next meeting
- New attorney needed: Kim reached out to Couri and Ruppe and they are not taking new clients at this time. Discussed hiring Shelley Ryan with Hoff Barry, PA, same firm used previously. **Brant made a motion to approve the legal firm and attorney from Hoff Barry, PA, Nick 2nd, vote 3-0 passes**
- Recycle bin on Secluded Rd: Resident mentioned that the recycle bin was missing from the area of Secluded Rd near the bike path. Ryan will place the one we have at Town Hall there. Kim will put in a request for a new one as the one we have is broken.
- AED: Resident brought up again the question of purchasing AEDs and it was decided several meetings ago that the Township would not be open to purchasing AEDs due to liability issue. They may at some point approve one for Town Hall.
- Boat dock and ramp: Hope to get the dock installed in the next couple of weeks.
- Traffic on Riverview Dr: Discussion about the excessive speed on Riverview Drive. A few residents present voiced their concerns and asked that patrolling may be needed. Marcia will mention to the Sheriff Dept and Kim will send an email too.

Dave made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:05pm
