**APPROVE MINUTES:** Review Regular meeting minutes 6/7/2022: **Brant makes a motion to approve the regular monthly minutes from 6/7/2022 as written, Nick 2<sup>nd</sup>, vote 3-0 passes.**

**Clerk/Treasurers Report:**

- Presented Treasurers report for June to the Board for filing. No discrepancies to report.
- Accounts Payable: **Nick makes a motion to approve all payables, Brant 2<sup>nd</sup>, vote 3-0 passes**
- Truck has been paid off
- 2023 Levy – **Brant made a motion to approve the 2023 Levy as written from the 2022 Annual Meeting (\$254,988.00) in March, Nick 2<sup>nd</sup>, vote 3-0 passes**
- State Audit update: Waiting on collateralization from BMO. Will submit to the State once that is received.

**Maintenance Business:** Road updates and prep, curbing on Mulder Rd on the railroad side where washing. Need to get a hold of the railroad and possible concrete bids for curbing. Plans to get 1-2 loads of sand for beach entrance area.

**Old Business:**

- Bathrooms at Park (grant): Winona Cty needed more information. County will be deciding on grant award July 13<sup>th</sup>.
- Boat ramp (grant): County will be deciding on grant award July 13<sup>th</sup>.
- Culvert Old Mill Rd: Spoke to Travis and he plans to get both Old Mill and Waas Valley done at the same time. No date has been set yet.
- Road Chip Seal update: Chip sealing has been completed on roads budgeted for and repairs/fills done on Queens Cove. Had an issue with an area on Queens Cove that will be addressed with the resident/contractor.
- Siding at Town Hall: Continue to have issues getting a start date from the contractor. Brant will reach out to discuss project completion.
- Waas Valley: Ryan will get some rock placed by the turn around edge.

**New Business:**

- Crystal Lewandowski case: Crystal has paid the Township in Full. Case is now closed.
- Mulder Road run off: As mentioned above, need to get a hold of railroad regarding curbing and possible culvert

**From the Floor:**

- Resident asked about the parking spaces at the Park. Signage communicates that the spaces are for “park use only and no overnight parking.” Also, explained that the Township didn’t have need for the concrete he has and advised where he could dump off of Oak Hill Rd.
